Every resident has the right to be safe from sexual abuse.

No one has the right to pressure you to engage in sexual acts. If you are being pressured, threatened or extorted for sex, you should <u>report it immediately.</u>

You will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.

VOASELA RRC has **ZERO TOLERANCE** for all forms of sexual conduct between residents, staff, volunteers, contractors or visitors.

If you are aware of any such conduct you must report it.
