## Canal Pointe Philosophy

We believe that every person who comes to us wants to improve their lives in a meaningful way and everyone's path to doing that may be different.

Our residential program includes approximately 3 months of residential care, followed by our Lagniappe Phase which offers community-based peer support aftercare for those in the Greater New Orleans area.

Our staff includes Licensed Mental Health Professionals, Registered Peer Support Specialists, Licensed Practical Nurses and other support professionals.

Our staff use a variety of evidence-based models including Matrix Model, Seeking Safety, Botvin LifeSkills Training Parent Program, Mind-Body Workbook for Addiction, Peer Support, Cognitive Behavioral Therapy, Relapse Prevention Therapy, and other therapeutic models.
